Joe Putrich acting as chairman, and Wilbur McClaughry as clerk the following official business was transacted:

After Pledge of Allegiance, the January 6, 2010 meeting minutes were reviewed. Motion by Jim Hootman to accept minutes. Seconded by Everett Lofftus. Motion carried.

The previous month's bills and receipts were reviewed by Supervisor Joe Putrich. Motion was made by Francis Clark to approve the Treasurer's report. Seconded by Everett Lofftus. Motion carried.

Supervisor Joe Putrich report: TOI training and educational seminar schedule available. Noted Trustee new book and throw old one away as there is some new changes. Couny TO to meet February 16th at Red Brick School at 6:00 for organizational meeting. R.s.v.p. 647-0124. Joe probably will go to East Peoria Training session April 16th if anyone else wants to go. Joe had asked Allan Woodruff Road Commissioner for MFT from county but has not received any report yet, will keep asking. Joe would like permission for an additional bulletin board for office and repair and more motion light on outside of building. Light needs to be higher and shine down instead of pointing out. Motion by Lisa Fahrenbruch to allow Joe to do both projects. Seconded by Jim Hootman. Roll call vote: Francis, yes; Lisa, yes; Everett, yes; Jim, yes. Motion carried.

Highway Commissioner Allan Woodruff was not present but left attached report: Joe had questions about where old grader blade was. Raymond Burgess said it was in bad shape and out back of Main Street building. Also questioned vehicle service report. Raymond reported Triple Creek Road still closed. Road District bills were reviewed and initialed by Trustees. Motion by Jim Hootman to allow payment of bills. Seconded by Everett Lofftus. Roll call vote: Francis, yes; Lisa, yes; Everett, yes; Jim yes. Motion carried.

Assessor Jim Mitchell's report; No County Supervisor of Assessments yet but could possibly know by next Tuesday, the 9th. Interim Supervisor Reba Ford's, ninety-day appointment is up tomorrow. Jim has been reviewing County Assessment report for township and some seem to be quite a bit different than actual value of property. Jim had last quarter of 09-10 year expense request and had budget prepared for 2010-11 year. Jim is taking a home school class but the school needs \$500 cost before receiving it. Joe will write check for the amount.
