Trustees report: Francis Clark - Cemetery Board ready to advertise for mowing bids. Lisa Fahrenbruch – nothing to report. Everett Lofftus – nothing to report. Jim Hootman Putt Creek Road is in bad shape.

Public comments: Ramona Fisher of Wee Ma Tuk reported during bad ice & snow storm, Poccahantus Road was real bad with very little effort to make it better. Her husband plowed his own drive and Poccahantus. Mrs Fisher called Allan Woodruff, Highway Commissioner and talked to his son. The son said his dad was stuck with road grader. She asked Allan to call her when he could. Son said he probably wouldn't have time to return her call. She did not appreciate the way she was treated over the phone. Frequently the pea gravel that was used on Poccahantus Hill washes down hill after thawing or rain and accumulates in front of resident's property at bottom of hill. Water can not drain because of bad ditching which affects Mrs Fisher's septic tank bed. Wee Ma Tuk residents need to contact County Highway Department and County Board for request not taken care of by Road Commissioner. Mr Fisher would help anytime township is in a bind of clearing roads. Emergency vehicles need to be able to get in and out if needed. Mr Fisher reported he was in Casey's General Store on Main St and overheard a woman comment about Road Commissioner clearing out her driveway and he thought that this was a no no.

Chris Strong would like to publish township minutes in Wee Ma Tuk website or township could have their own website. He would charge just the cost. Joe will contact Attorney McCarthy about legal aspect. Board will discuss at later meetings.
